### GENERAL INFORMATION

- >> **Noise Limitations**

The maximum noise limit of 130 dB(A) per car (according to DMSB noise regulations, blue part, Art. 2-4, Chapter 1&2) must be observed
- >> **During the sessions**

During the truck tests, the pit box doors to the pit lane of the PCG teams must be kept closed. Access to the pit lane is prohibited for PCG team members and guest. The same applies to the truck teams during the PCG test sessions.
- >> **Pit walk**

A pit walk will take place on both test days at the times marked "Lunch Break" in the time schedule, during which all pit box doors to the pit lane must be kept open. There will also be a track announcer, please be prepared that he may invite you or your drivers for an interview.
- >> **Team Manager Meeting**

ADAC and Creventic will organize a meeting with team managers and manufacturers during the test days. The time and place will be communicated on-site.

### ORDER INFORMATION

- >> **Transponder**

MyLaps direct power transponder with driver-ID. In case you do not have transponder yet, the local timekeeper has some available for purchase and rental (Wige).
- >> **Datalogger**

As per Series regulations
- >> **Michelin Tyres**

Make sure to order Michelin Tyres with Kronos (only tyres ordered with Kronos are allowed). Michelin has informed us that there are sufficient tyres available for the duration of track time available during the pre-season test, however the maximum allocated amount is 3 sets of slick tyres and 1 set of rain tyres per car. This is due to the shortage of raw materials and effect every series running on Michelin tyres. Michelin is working hard to solve this issue and can confirm that the tyre supply for the entire season is secured. The statement can be found in the email from 31-03-2022.

- >> **Fuel**

There is no mandatory fuel supplier for the test days. However, it is possible to order the official fuel that will be used during the races by P1 Racing Fuels at [contact@sdtec.fr](mailto:contact@sdtec.fr)
- >> **Team Catering**

Please note that there is no team catering available on track during the test days. During any other events in the season there will be possibilities.

### PIT BOX & PADDOCK INFORMATION

- >> **Pit box**

Pit boxes are included for all Prototype Cup Germany teams. It is allowed to store a maximum of 200 litres of fuel inside each box.
- >> **Pit box keys**

The keys can be collected in the control tower (start-zielhaus) from the Nürburgring front desk against a deposit.
- >> **Pit Box Allocation**

- >> **Toilets & showers**

The toilets at T10 and the showers in the paddock will be open
- >> **WiFi**

WiFi is available free of charge in most of the pit boxes

**TEAM INFORMATION PRE-SEASON TEST NÜRBURGRING 2022 V2: 31-02-2022****SIGN-ON TEST DAYS**

- » **Sign-on test days** The sign-on will take place on Sunday evening from 18:00 until 19:30 in the Prototype Cup Germany office.
- » **Please bring with you** Please make sure to bring the following with you to the sign-on of the test days:
  - Printed and signed entry form (two copies)
  - Original licenses of drivers and teams (also a copy of the license)
- » **Additional drivers** Additional drivers (with a valid license) can be only be named at the test in our office and need to sign the entry form before going on track. Drivers without a signed entry form are not allowed to drive.

**ACCESS INFORMATION**

- » **First access** Please use the digital access pass (Durchfahrtsschein) to get first access to the paddock. You can afterwards collect your tickets for the test days in the Prototype Cup Germany office in the control tower.
- » **Access to paddock & pit box** On Saturday 2 April, team trucks are allowed to line-up at "Am Scharfen Kopf". On Sunday 3 April starting at 17:00 teams can access the paddock and pit box.
- » **Parking** It is possible to park in the paddock with passenger cars. Per competing vehicle 4 passenger cars are allowed.

**COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

- » **Restrictions** It is unclear at the moment which rules will be valid in Rhineland-Palatinate from the 3<sup>rd</sup> of April onwards. It looks like there will be no access restrictions, however until the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April there restrictions in place. Please be prepared that medical masks may be mandatory indoors and that 3G access restrictions may be in place (3G = fully vaccinated, recovered or tested negative).
